#### K-2 GRADE

- The kindergartners are learning the letter "Oo" and the number "14". In math they are working on putting numbers in order from least to greatest. They are learning how to write sentences and have been playing comprehension games. The first graders are learning how to measure using different objects. The second graders are learning clocks and expanded notation. In the afternoons the students have been learning about the solar system.
