#### CLASSROOM UPDATES

##### K-2 GRADE

- The kindergartners are learning the letter "Ww" and "23". They have also been working on subtraction in math. They are also practicing their addresses, phone numbers and tying shoes. The students learned about St. Patrick's Day. The first and second grades are learning about nonfiction stories and poetry. They made a St. Patrick's Days story, craft and graphed Lucky Charms.
