### CLASSROOM UPDATES

#### K-2 GRADE

- On Monday, The Red Scarf Society brought in Irish music to our school. They had several instruments, played several songs and was very interactive with the students. Afterwards they came to the classroom and the children learned how to play a bodhrán with a tipper on boxes. They had an amazing time. On Tuesday, Mr. Doty came in and presented American Indian folktales. He was very enthralling and the students were totally engaged. This was perfect since they studied folktales a couple of weeks ago. On Friday, they made their own musical instruments. The first and second grades also studied and wrote their own similes.

#### 3-5 GRADE

- This week the 3rd-5th graders have had many enrichments. On Monday the students listened and viewed a great musical performance. Then, they were able to practice a type of crude bodhrán drum and worked with making rhythms. Also, the American Red Cross came and spoke about flash floods. #### 6-8 GRADE

- After the Irish music performance, the upper grade class was treated to penny whistle lessons with each student receiving their own whistle.
