### CLASSROOM UPDATES

#### K-2 GRADE

- The kindergartners are learning the letter "Oo" and the number "15". All students should have their poems memorized. In math, the first graders are working on "greater than" and "less than". The second graders are working on money. In the afternoons, they learned about Groundhog Day. Have a great three-day weekend!

#### 3-5 GRADE

- Students have been working on reading and math assessments. We started Unit 4 in math. The third grade kicked off the unit with a lesson on measurement. If you ask your student to measure you, they can now do so in both inches and centimeters. The fourth grade is working on extended multiplication facts. The fifth grade is working on decimals. We plotted decimals on a table as we discussed how the numbers increase as you move to the left and decrease as you move farther to the right of the decimal point. #### 6-8 GRADE

- Hello Families! This week we've been taking a deeper look into the Civil War and the economic effect it had on the families left at home to care for loved ones and the land they owned.
