Student School Work To Continue

Students will be expected to complete school work from home. Staff will be working normal school hours to continue planning lessons and activities for students at home. Teachers and aides will be calling students to check in on work progress and provide support. Each teacher will work with individual families in the best form of communication for them. Phone calls, Class Dojo, Facetime, Zoom, and Google Classroom will all be utilized to help support student learning from home. Your commitment to having students complete work at home, ensures that we will not have to extend the school year.

- 11:30am Delphic and Gazelle Elementary School, stay in car, we will bring to your door
- 12:00pm Yreka, Lower Greenhorn Park
- 12:45pm Montague City Park
- 1:15pm Grenada, Shell Station Parking Lot
